Following pronouncements made on 10th June 2019 by the Minister of Agricultural Development & Food Security, Honorable Fidelis Molao - to introduce a P3/Kg drought-subsidy on slaughter prices at all BMC abattoirs – the new prices have been effected as per the following guide;
